

Adobe GoLive Website Development Application

This script was developed directly from the first lesson on Developing Web Sites with Adobe GoLive CS in the book Adobe GoLive CS Classroom in a Book, revised edition © 2004 Adobe Systems.

SCRIPT - DEVELOPING WEBSITES WITH ADOBE GOLIVE CS

1. Launch GoLive

New Site

Single user

Blank Site

Site Name : Matchbox

Specify save location, <FINISH>

2. Double click index.html page to open a blank home page in DOCUMENT WINDOW

3. SITE WINDOW at bottom of screen, FILES tab

<FILE><IMPORT><FILES TO SITE>

<LESSONS><LESSON01><01START> select the MEDIA folder <OPEN>

4. SITE WINDOW at bottom of screen, FILES tab

GoLive Toolbar <NEW FOLDER>

Rename to PAGES

5. Back to the index.html in the DOCUMENT WINDOW

Change the title to **First Strike Matches**

Note the pre-set page sizes to view entire layout

6. OBJECTS PALETTE - BASIC - LAYOUT GRID

7. OBJECTS PALETTE - BASIC - LAYOUT TEXT BOX

Within the text box type **Welcome to First Strike Matches** <return>

**For answers to your burning questions about our matches,
use the links below.**

8. Format text by highlighting and choosing from the toolbar

Welcome to First Strike Matches centered, bold and header 2

9. Save the File.

10. Back to text box and highlight **Welcome to First Strike Matches**.

Open the Color palette, choose RGB color space, Color = CC6600

11. Change background color of the page.

Open the Inspector palette, PAGE tab, set background to 66CCCC.

12. Save the File.

13. Add images to home page

Open the Objects palette, drag an IMAGE icon to the right of the text box.

In the Inspector palette, link via pick whip to **matchbox.gif**.

14. Change the grid height to 360 using the Inspector palette.

15. Add two more image icons to the bottom of the page.

Link to **features.gif** (left) and **questions.gif** (right).

16. Save the File. Preview in browser(internal & external). Show HTML code. Close.

17. Page two. using a prebuilt starting point.

SITE window active, <FILE><IMPORT><FILES TO SITE>

<LESSONS><LESSON01><01START> select QUESTIONS.HTML file <OPEN>.

18. Open QUESTIONS.HTML into the document window.

Link upper left to **burning.gif**

Link lower left to **questions2.gif**

Link lower center to **features.gif**

Link lower right to **main.gif**

19. Save the File.

20. Create a rollover. Drag an image icon to top, right of title.

Link the new image icon to **box.gif**.

Rollover palette automatically opens since an _over file of the same name

is in the same folder. Rollover is set-up automatically by default.

Do a preview to show the rollover action.

21. Save the File.

22. Close Questions page, go to Site Window & select EXTRAS tab in the right pane.

CTRL-Drag and Drop to the STATIONARY folder.

Rename to the stationary file to **fs_stationary.html** using the Inspector palette.

23. Formatting a table, Back to Questions.html document window.

<FILE><OPEN> choose **table_text.html**. Move pointer over top of table until box arrow appears & then select the whole table and a border appears around the entire table.

<CTRL><C> to put on clipboard, then close the **table_text.html** file.

Make Questions.html document window active, nothing selected.

<EDIT><PASTE> to put tabel. Move to desired position.

24. Formatting the table, open the Table Inspector palette. Table selected.

0 for BORDER to remove border.

5 for CELL PAD to reduce the spece around the text in the table cells.

Select What is a match? : +5 FONT SIZE.

Select What is Fire and Why won't my light? : +5 FONT SIZE.

Save file and then Preview.

25. Add External Link - EXTERNAL Tab in Site Window left

OBJECTS PALETTE, SITE ITEMS tab, drag MAIL icon to EXTERNAL tab

Fill in name and link e-mail address desired

Highlight "e-mail us" in lower part of table, Inspector link to External folder item

26. Add Multimedia. Scroll down below table.

Drag a QuickTime icon from the BASIC set on the OBJECTS palette;
centered below the table.

In the Plug-In Inspector palette, link to **strike.mov** on the BASIC tab.

In the PLUG-IN tab, deselect AUTOPLAY and select SHOW CONTROLLER.

25. Save file & then Preview. Click > arrow in controller to start the movie. Close page.

26. Adding the third page. Back to the SITE window and the EXTRAS tab at the right.

Drag & drop **fs_stationary.html** page into the pages folder,

CREATE in the dialog box.

Name the new page **features.html**.

Move the **Questions.html** file into the pages folder if not already there.

27. Open the new **features.html** page in the document window.

Change the title to **Product Features for First Strike Matches**.

Select image at top of page and re-link to **product.gif**.

28. Drawing added to Product Features page.

Add an image icon below title from the OBJECTS palette BASIC set.

In Image inspector, pick whip to **chart.gif**

29. Save file and then Preview. Close the page.

30. Add the navigation links to INDEX.HTML.

Open **index.html** in the document window.

Select text **burning questions** ; in Text Inspector palette check the create a link option and link to **questions.html**.

Select the FEATURES image icon at bottom left of page.

Link to **features.html** in Image Inspector LINK tab after checking create a link.

Select the QUESTIONS image icon at bottom right of page.

Link to **questions.html** in Image Inspector LINK tab after checking create a link.

31. Repeat process to add the navigational links to FEATURES.HTML &

QUESTIONS.HTML.

32. Save file and then Preview. Preview in full Browser.
