

## What is a Blog

#### Wikipedia

- is a type of <u>website</u>, usually maintained by an individual with regular entries of commentary, descriptions of events, or other material such as graphics or video.
- Entries are commonly displayed in reversechronological order.
- Blog" can also be used as a verb, meaning to maintain or add content to a blog.

#### Derivation of the word BLOG

- The term "weblog" was coined by <u>Jorn Barger</u> on 17 December 1997.
- The short form, "blog," was coined by Peter Merholz, who jokingly broke the word *weblog* into the phrase *we blog* in the sidebar of his blog Peterme.com in April or May 1999.
- Shortly thereafter, <u>Evan Williams</u> at <u>Pyra Labs</u> used "blog" as both a noun and verb ("to blog," meaning "to edit one's weblog or to post to one's weblog") and devised the term "blogger" in connection with Pyra Labs' <u>Blogger</u> product, leading to the popularization of the terms.

## **Types of Blogs**

#### Personal blogs

 The personal blog, an ongoing diary or commentary by an individual, is the traditional, most common blog.

#### Corporate blogs

 Blogs, either used internally to enhance the communication and culture in a <u>corporation</u> or externally for <u>marketing</u>, <u>branding</u> or <u>public</u> relations

## Types of Blogs (Cont.)

#### By genre

- Some blogs focus on a particular subject
- Political blogs, travel blogs, house blogs, fashion blogs, project blogs, education blogs, niche blogs, classical music blogs, quizzing blogs and legal blogs (often referred to as a blawgs) or dreamlogs.
- Two common types of genre blogs are <u>art blogs</u> and <u>music blogs</u>.

## Types of Blogs (Cont.)

#### By media type

- A blog comprising videos is called a <u>vlog</u>,
- A site comprising links is called a <u>linklog</u>,
- A site containing a portfolio of sketches is called a sketchblog
- A site comprising photos is called a <u>photoblog</u>.


#### By device

- Blogs can also be defined by which type of device is used to compose it.
- A blog written by a <u>mobile device</u> like a <u>mobile phone</u> or <u>PDA</u> could be called a <u>moblog</u>



## How to Create a Travel Blog Process

- Register on blog website
- Prepare photos
  - Only a few
- Prepare text
  - I used Microsoft Word offline to prepare and edit text
- Logon to blog website
- Upload Text
  - using copy and paste
- Insert Photos
  - Drag photos
    - to correct placement in text
- Publish



# Potential Issues on Creating Travel Blog

- Getting access to the Internet on the road
  - Hotel/Motels with Internet
    - Some are free and others charge by the hour
  - Internet Cafes
    - Need to eat or drink
    - May limit the amount of time
    - Need to carry laptop to Cafe
  - Internet Stores
    - Charge by the hour
    - Need to carry laptop to Cafe

# Potential Issues on Creating Travel Blog (continued)

- Your internet time may be charged by the hour
- Your time is limited since you want to sightsee and do other things
- Recommendation
  - Prepare blog off-line using Microsoft Word or other word processor
  - Upload blog to server
  - May still need to reset photos
